Etang de Baye-Vaux

Reservoirs linked to the Nivernais canal, these ponds created in the 19th century sheltering a remarkable eco-system with signed and documented footpaths allowing you to discover the area all year round. Listed as "sensitive natural areas", the visit requires respect for each other and also allows nautical activities and fishing

Château de Lantilly

Le château de Lantilly is a large building erected on the site of a gallo-roman villa called Lentulli, after the family name of its owner, Lentulus, from Gentilice Cornelie, one of the oldest and most famous houses of the antique Rome that Scipio, Sylla, Cethegus and Cinna I also belonged to.

Lantilly est situated on the right bank of the Anguisson river.

This ancient fortress originally had six towers and two concentric moats with draw-bridges surrounding its low and high courts and dungeon. The château de Lantilly is renowned for its occupation by Anglo-Navarre armed companies in 1358-59.

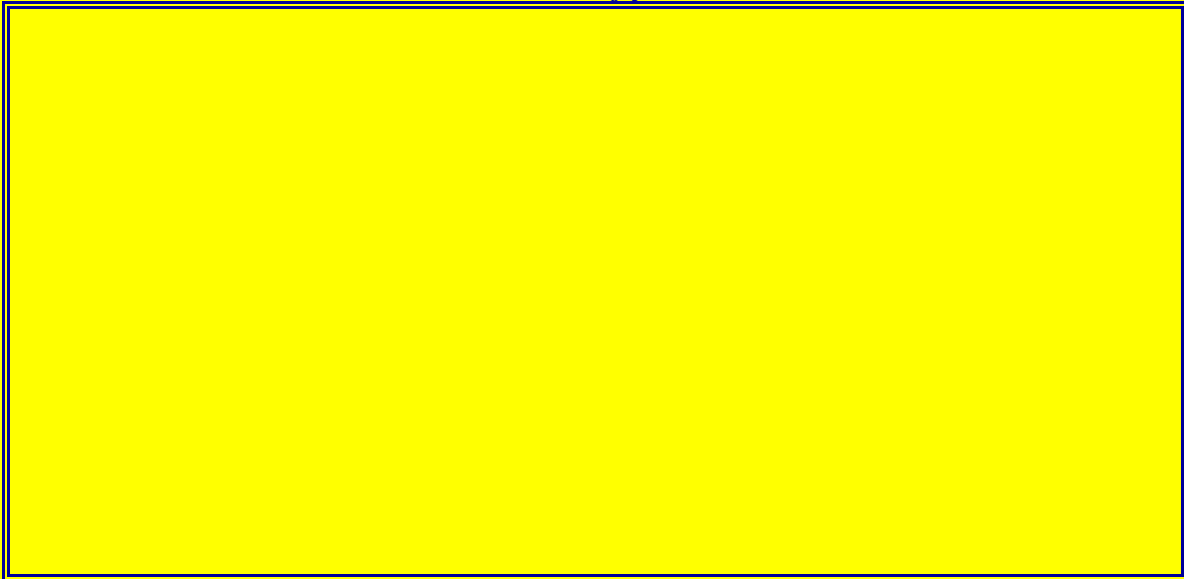
